At New Jersey Brain Care, we pride ourselves in providing compassionate and individualized care to all patients in a healing and supportive environment. However, our top priority is the safety and health of our patients.

We are excited to announce that the office of New Jersey Brain Care will begin seeing patients for neuropsychological evaluations at the end of this month. As we enter this new phase and begin preparing for our re-opening, we want to make all patients, caregivers, families, and referring physicians aware of the steps we are taking to do so safely. Neuropsychological evaluations involve standardized testing that can only be done face-to-face without the presence of a facemask. Therefore, the steps that we are taking in order to re-open are vastly important for not only the safety of our patients, but our doctors as well.

As we adjust our schedules and office flow to support recommendations by the CDC, we ask for your patience and understanding as we move through difference phases of reopening. Our testing room is equipped with a full plexiglass shield to prevent the exposure and travel of air droplets; a microphone and speaker system to ensure that communication will remain clear on both sides of the shield; and two separate entry ways into the testing room for the doctor and patient; limiting the amount of contact. Restroom facilities will also be separate.

Here is what to expect with our plans of re-opening:

1. All consultations and diagnostic interviews will be conducted via telehealth (video call) starting June 15th. Only after the interview or consultation is conducted can the evaluation be scheduled with the provider.
2. There will be only one evaluation conducted at the clinic at a time. Our providers will be alternating work schedules to provide access to care while allowing for social distancing. Likewise, sanitation and cleaning days will be scheduled in between full days of testing.
3. Patients and staff will be required to wear masks (cloth or surgical) while in the office until they are in the testing room securely behind the plexiglass barrier, at which point they will take them off for testing. If you have a caregiver who needs to attend the visit with you upon arrival, he or she will also need to wear a mask. Please inform staff if this is the case.
4. We ask that patients and caregivers wait outside of the office building until they are called in for their appointment. We will not be utilizing the waiting room in our office, but will have a bench outside that patients are welcome to use.
5. If you need assistance during your visit, we ask that the person who brings you in either waits in his/her car until your appointment is over or waits on our outdoor bench to help us limit the number of people in the clinic at any one time.
6. Upon arrival, each patient (and caregiver, if there is one) will have their temperature taken and will be asked specific COVID-19 screening questions.

7. Once the testing begins, only the patient and doctor will be allowed in the office. All caregivers must wait outside or return home until testing is complete (The doctor will give the caregiver a call when testing is almost done).
8. We will gather information through as many contactless ways as possible and will establish hand sanitizing protocols for everyone.
9. We will communicate any changes as we move through this process. Please let us know the best way to share information with you.
